Mosquitoes.

Many of us are annoyed by mosquitoes, and if you are bothered by these pesky biters, I would recommend installing a Purple Martin birdhouse. Purple Martins are very small birds with a voracious appetite for insects. A group of them can eat thousands each day. They also like beetles, flies, moths and dragon flies. The birdhouse sits atop a pole and has multiple openings. The openings are too small for most other birds, but the martins like to group together in their little apartments. Perhaps you have seen several small gourds hung close together, and wondered what they were for. The martins will spend five months with us, and then return the next year to breed and eat mosquitoes!

Lakeside Erosion

Several lake owners have asked how to mitigate erosion of their banks. Solitude Lake Management suggests adding vegetation along the bank. The roots will help hold the soil. They also have a method of reinforcing the bank by inserting a dirt bag under the grass. You can go to Solitudelakemanagement.com and look over all their good ideas
